May 15, 2020- TDLA FREE CLE webinar- **“The ex parte statute is constitutional—sort of. Now what?”** - TDLA Professional Negligence and Healthcare Co-Chair **Chris Vrettos** of *Gideon, Cooper and Essary, PLC* will present our next TDLA Free webinar on May 15th at Noon CST/ 1pm EST. On February 28, 2020, the Supreme Court of Tennessee, in *Willeford v. Klepper, et al.*, invalidated Tenn. Code Ann. §29-26-121(f) (permitting health care defendants to apply for a QPO for ex parte treating provider interviews) as enacted, but upheld an elided version of the statute making it discretionary rather than mandatory. In this CLE, Health Care Section Co-Chair (and *Willeford* counsel for Appellee Livingston Regional Hospital) Chris Vrettos will cover the rationale behind the majority’s opinion and the implications of the decision for future practice. 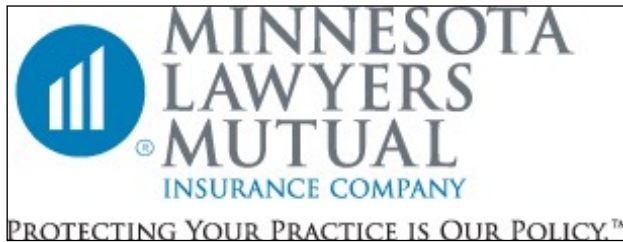
